THE ORGAN

The organ was originally built for Borthwick Church, Midlothian in 1893 by the renowned Hull firm of organ-builders, Forster and Andrews. Replacing a poor-quality electronic instrument, the organ was installed in the West Gallery by David Wood of Huddersfield between February and August 2020. The new organ fits well with the church's neo-Gothic style, its pipes being beautifully painted and gilded in the manner of that period.
